

**KAPPA DELTA EPSILON
NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Every year, National KDE awards up to \$9,000 in scholarships to members of local Alumni and Collegiate chapters “in good standing”. Scholarship awards may be used for undergraduate or graduate school tuition. Scholarship awards of \$750 each are available for up to 10 undergraduate and 2 graduate applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be sponsored by a local Alumni or Collegiate KDE chapter, of which they are a member.
- Applicants must have a National number assigned by the National Treasurer.
- Applicants must have been admitted to Teacher Education and have at least one quarter or semester of school remaining after the scholarship is awarded.

In addition, applicants must complete the National KDE Scholarship Application and include a personal letter, a copy of their college transcript(s), two letters (in PDF form) of recommendation (one must be from the chapter adviser), and a jpeg of an appropriate head-shot to include in *The Current*.

All required information must be submitted via email to the Scholarship Chair on or before March 1st.
